Monday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Phonics Video 1. Please make sure children have a piece of paper and pencil ready. They will need to be able to pause and play the video when needed.</li> <li>➤ Watch the Introduction to the week video. (please see separate observation)</li> </ul> <p>Activity: Write a list of what a school needs. Maybe toilets, chairs etc.</p> <p>Remember to write your letters the right way around sitting on the line.</p>	<p>Watch the video <a href="https://vimeo.com/490879063">https://vimeo.com/490879063</a></p> <p>Activity: Choose a number card, roll the dice and then count on that many. i.e. choose number card 13, roll a 2 on the dice and then count on- 14,15.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Look at the PDF/powerpoint for R.E. We are looking at parables this half term. This week we are learning about the lost sheep. There is a sorting activity to go with this. If you are unable to print the sheet then please get the children to draw and write their own retelling of the story.</li> <li>- Build a new classroom out of junk- what different things can you add inside.</li> <li>- Design a new school playground for Mr Bayes- what would you like to have, label the picture to show us your ideas. Think about colours and shapes we might see</li> <li>- Can you label your picture of the playground with the materials you would use to make them i.e. wood for the climbing frame, material for the rope swing.</li> <li>- This term we are doing Line Dancing:  Watch the video of the children dancing. Is there any toys that you would like? Any special features like a zoo or race track?</p> <p>Remember to write in full sentences using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. <p>Wednesday</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Phonic video 3</li> <li>➤ Draw your ideas from yesterday and then label your picture.</li> </ul> <p>Remember when we label we tend to write one or two words and draw a line to the picture.</p>	<p>Watch the video <a href="https://vimeo.com/490879867">https://vimeo.com/490879867</a></p> <p>Activity: Start the sheet named Wednesday and Thursday number bonds. Encourage the children to use a number line (they can make their own) or counters/cars/bricks anything they would like to solve the questions.</p>	<p>forward and backwards movements. Can you remember them all?</p> <p>Aa, Bb, Cc etc.</p>	<p>Watch the video <a href="https://vimeo.com/490880277">https://vimeo.com/490880277</a></p> <p>Activity: continue with the sheet from yesterday. If your child has finished then get them to write their own addition sums in the books using numbers to 20.</p>	
<p>Friday</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Phonics- play 2 of the key word games, I have attached the ideas sheet and words again if you need them.</li> <li>➤ Handwriting Practise writing the letters r,n,m,w, Once you have written a row of letters can you think of some words with these letters in them?</li> </ul>	<p>Watch the video <a href="https://vimeo.com/490882337">https://vimeo.com/490882337</a></p> <p>Activity: complete the sheet labelled Friday make number bonds.</p> <p>They will find the questions that look like this <math>20 = \square + 6</math> a lot harder than the usual <math>\square + 6 = 20</math>. It is best to use objects that the children can count and move to help them.</p>
